- July 5th** **DR. HARP BLUES REVUE BAND**
(A four-piece blues band specializing in the driving boogie blues popularized by Johnny Winter, George Thorogood and the J. Geils Band; a sound that owes equal debts to Chuck Berry and John Lee Hooker. Dennis Martin took up the harmonica at age 10; over a 30-year professional career, he's performed all over the world, including the former Soviet Union, and opened for everyone from B.B. King to Steppenwolf.)
- July 12th** **THE TAMMY JACKSON BAND**
(Perennial favorites, Tammy Jackson and Cliff Clegg return to the summer stage with their band *and* special guests. This "Fulton Sister's" Reunion brings Tammy's sister Traci back into the spotlight, joined by Tammy's musical (of course) daughter, Katherine Jackson Lewis. Together they'll perform some of their favorite country classics with harmonies only family can create. Don't be surprised if the Fulton family patriarch, Keith Fulton, and brothers Jason and Troy don't join in, as well. Tammy, Cliff and their family never fail to please their audiences with lots of laughter and *great* country music.)
- July 19th** **WIGHTMAN & CLEGG BAND**
(Top-notch musicians Bill Wightman and Cliff Clegg team up to perform jazz and rock covers with their own unique twist (Elton meets Eric) – Dynamic – Funky – Cool. Tonight they're joined by Tim Gilmore on percussion, Matt Langley on tenor sax, and Scott Kiefner on bass.)
- July 26th** **THE FLAMES**
(A four piece "Rock & Roll" band playing music of the 50s, 60s & 70s with three vocalists including John Lovejoy on keyboards, Cam Cross on guitar, Eric von Ammon on drums and Terry Langford on tenor sax.)
- Aug. 2nd** **THE EAST BAY JAZZ ENSEMBLE**
(A 12 to 14 piece big band featuring Gerry Grimo with lots of brass performing all the "big band" favorites these town bandstands summer music series are famous for.)

- Aug. 9th THE TICKET**
(Based in Keene, NH, this Dance/Rock Band performs all the music a DJ can deliver with an exciting show that a DJ could never do! Musicians include Steve Pro (Vocals), Cliff Clegg (Guitars and Vocals), Bill Wightman (Keyboards), Sean Lake (Bass and Vocals), Jody Bregler (Drums and Vocals). <http://www.theticketband.net/>)
- Aug. 16th FLEW-Z**
Rock/Pop cover band based in Newport, NH featuring Logan Flewelling on guitar, Kyle Flewelling on drums, Eric Stone on bass with Alec Currior on vocals.
- Aug. 23rd BILL ROSEN QUINTET**
(From NH's Upper Valley and nearby Vermont, this group of ten years, plus plays jazz and swing standards. Musicians include Bill Rosen on guitar, Norm Yanofsky on keyboards, Eric Bronstein on upright bass, Nick Scalera on tenor sax, and Jim Macnutt on drums and percussion.)
- Aug. 30th MO'COMBO**
(One of the Upper Valleys favorite bands, this "combo" offers classic R&B, straight ahead blues, and New Orleans bayou funk, featuring strong vocals, smooth harmonies, and a smokin' horn section. Musicians include Dana Flewelling [drums]; Skip Truman [bass & vocals]; Will Michaels [guitar & vocals]; Scott Sanborn [keyboard & vocals]; with various horn players. Mo'Combo performs musical intricacies and subtleties that are just plain FUN! with a rhythm section that will jump right into your pocket and stay there until long after the last note is played.)
